REGULATIONS

PART I PRELIMINARY

1. Short title and commencement-(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Fair Trading (Approved Eggs Standards) Regulations 2010.

(2) Regulation 21(3) comes into force on 10 May 2010, and the remainder of the Regulations shall commence 12 months later.

2. Objective - The objective of these Regulations is to ensure product safety and quality standards of eggs for human consumption.

3. Scope-(1) These Regulations apply to:

- (a) egg handlers; and
- (b) the primary production, sorting, grading, storing, transporting, packaging, distributing, and supplying of eggs by domesticated chicken intended for human consumption.

(2) These Regulations do not apply to an egg product or traditional delicacy eggs such as 1000 year old eggs.
