Pursuant to the ***Daylight Saving Act 2009*** and Cabinet's decision FK (19) 10, businesses and the general public are hereby advised that daylight saving time ends on **Sunday 7th of April 2019**.

The public is therefore advised that when the standard time strikes the hour of **four o'clock (4:00am)** on the **7th April 2019**, then all instruments used to measure standard time are to be adjusted/changed to **three o'clock (3:00am)**. However, we advise that you adjust your time an hour back before you retire to bed on Saturday night, the 6th of April.
