In accordance with section 2 of the Public Holidays Act 2008, the public, government agencies, and the private sector are hereby advised that **Tuesday, 1<sup>st</sup> June 2021** is to be treated as a Public Holiday to commemorate Samoa's Independence.

Shops selling goods may open during public holidays in accordance with the provisions of the Public Holidays Act 2008. However, employers are reminded to comply with section 39 of the Labour and Employment Relations Act 2013 in relation to the rate of wages to be paid to employees who work on Public Holidays.

Please note the *Amended State of Emergency Order (46) dated 14<sup>th</sup> May 2021* is in effect. Accordingly, the public and private sector must adhere to this order. The opening hours for supermarkets are as follows:

- **Monday - Saturday: 6am – 10pm**
- **Sunday: 3pm – 10pm**
