### **DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME**

Pursuant to the ***Daylight Saving Act*** 2009 and Cabinet's decision FK (19) 32, businesses and the general public are hereby advised that daylight saving time is on **Sunday, 29<sup>th</sup> of September 2019**.

The public is therefore advised that when the standard time strikes the hour of **three o'clock (3:00am)** on the **29<sup>th</sup> September 2019**, then all instruments used to measure standard time are to be adjusted/changed to **four o'clock (4:00am)**. However, we advise that you adjust your time an hour forward before you retire to bed on Saturday night, the 28<sup>th</sup> of September.
